News From Teen Feed

On Wednesday mornings a staff member and peer volunteer roam the streets of downtown Seattle, offering coffee, oatmeal, granola bars and clean socks to the youth who live on the streets there. We hope that some of the youth will begin to access our services and begin to turn their lives around, achieving transitional housing, sobriety, and education. One group accepted the coffee and chatted for a few minutes. As our folks began to move away one of the youths asked if they accepted donations. He said he had a little extra money and he would like to help. He took a dollar out of his pocket and handed it to the staff member. He spends his nights sleeping on hard concrete but wanted to support other young people in the same situation.
